Were Gothic Churches Powered Up by Earth Energies?

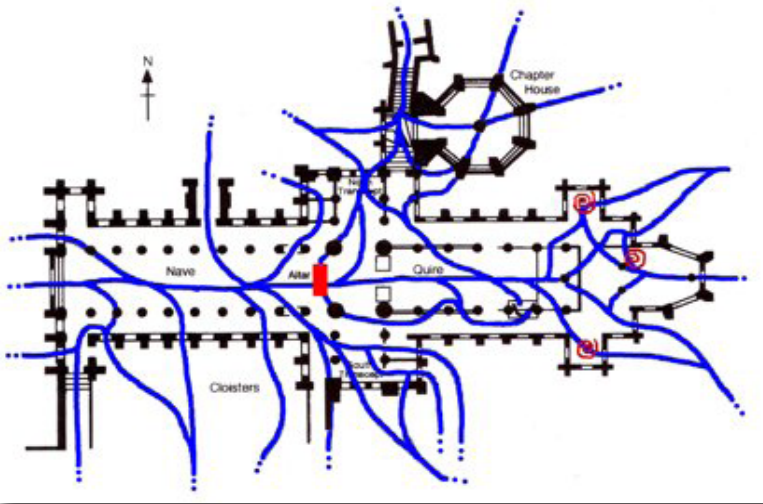

A Review of Richard Nissen's Lecture by Nigel Twinn, 2023*

The irrepressibly enthusiastic BSD stalwart Richard Nissen has been dowsing for a couple of decades. He is probably best known for his ground-breaking research into the navigational abilities of migrating birds.

He has been bravely trying to persuade mainstream scientists and naturalists that tiny creatures looking for geographical or climatological way-markers, whilst flying over thousands of square miles of barely distinguishable open ground and ocean, that they may never have previously experienced in any material form, is actually a very big ask.

A much simpler explanation, and a much better fit for phenomenon, is that the birds are getting their navigational data straight from the information field. i.e. that they are dowsing their way across the world, with a little help from inherited genetics. However, on this occasion, Richard was proposing another - perhaps similar - scenario. Could it be that modern churches and Cathedrals, built over former pre-Christian sacred sites, were established by people who knew, or at least sensed where the best place existed in any given area to be at one with the universe (or however they might have phrased such an idea)?

Here Richard presented detail of both his own experience, and the work of others, to indicate that probably all pre-reformation churches, and certainly all Gothic cathedrals, were sited according to earth energy currents and to sacred geometry. Richard may not be the first to discuss these ideas in the public domain, but his talk certainly generated a lot of interest. Many participants were keen to add their own observations and dowsing information - and the subsequent discussion actually lasted far

longer than the original presentation. This was clearly the objective.

The debate brought out many aspects of how churches have been designed to accommodate and to accentuate the earth energy patterns beneath them.

A good *'airing'* was also given to the debate about whether the energy in a sacred place was present before the construction of it, or whether it had been attracted or generated by the participants across many centuries. As ever, there was a general consensus that both inputs were instrumental in producing the energetic experience that we have today. Those originally using the location do seem to have been drawn to locations where earth energies were felt to be the strongest.

However, successive cultures and generations appear to have built on this foundation to produce ever more complex and integrated patterns of manifest energy currents and features. Perhaps the seminal work on the subject in the modern era is probably *'Dowsing and Church Archaeology'* (1988) by Richard N. Bailey, Eric Cambridge and H. Denis Briggs, which has a foreword written by the renowned archaeologist and Cornish Historian, Prof. Charles Thomas CBE.

Historians of dowsing have discussed how the craft was kept alive and revitalised by French Catholic monks (who presumably had the time and the ability to study the architecture and tangible energies of the religious buildings where they resided). The study of sacred sites for this purpose was re-discovered during the revival of - what we now term - earth energy dowsing, in the post war era. However, it is only since the 1970's that the subject has become generally available to a wider audience,

Even a couple of decades ago, dowsing in a church often required a degree of secrecy. Today, while it still is appropriate to be aware of the sensitivities of churchgoers, increasingly vicars and priests can be genuinely interested to appreciate one of the underlying reasons for their church to have become considered a sacred place.

Many a time, people have wondered at why such a significant building was built in this particular place, as opposed to a seemingly more suitable site a few hundred yards away - let alone those churches that are built outside of a community altogether, even on the top of a local hill! Earth energy dowsing in such religious buildings brings a new dimension both to the form and the function of their architecture.

I have personally dowsed at Eastern Orthodox churches and around Buddhist temples, with similar results. However, to date, I have no knowledge of any similar work carried out by members of the Hindu, Jewish or Islamic traditions.

Richard's zoom also focused on one of the topical big issues of the day. If crossing earth energies raise awareness, and even altered a state of mind or consciousness, what would it do to someone engaged in a ceremony that was centred on just such a spot. The case in point is the location of where the Kings and Queens of England are ritualistically crowned in the highest church of the nation - Westminster Abbey.

Richard explained that the crowning ceremony takes place exactly over the spiralling earth energy patterns of the Cosmati Pavement in the cathedral. What impact will that have on the new King - and indeed, how did it affect his predecessors? Richard asks us all to dowse the patterns for ourselves, and indeed to remote dowse the ceremony itself!

You don't have to be a '*died-in-the-wool*' Royalist to appreciate the symbolic significance of this ceremony. The discussion continued to consider not just the earth energy input to the event, but also the fact that Charles III will be adorned with massive bejewelled head covering. Each piece of

this magnificent crown will be powering up both his own brainwaves and the energies in his aura - and those in the surrounding environment.



And all of this on top of the mental focus of millions of viewers in person, on screen, online and across the world. There are times when it is probably beneficial not to be too sensitive to the non-physical, but we shall see. Drought in California has brought the practice of dowsing, or ‘*water-witching*,’ back into vogue.

The attempt to find water, gemstones, oil, metals, graves and underground tunnels with this method is nothing new. It may have had its origin in 15th-century Germany.

Tools of the trade involve anything from a Y-shaped branch clipped from a willow tree to L-shaped metal rods, which twist in the hands of the user. Sometimes a pendulum is employed. Supposedly, ‘*energies*’ from the desired discoveries transmit through the earth and cause a wooden branch



to move downward, or in the case of two rods, point in the direction of the operator's aspirations. While my grandfather firmly believed in the technique for finding water in the foothills, my science-oriented father ridiculed the whole process as nothing more than superstition.

Personal experience for me with dowsing began in the Army. I had a week to go until my departure from active duty.

It was the first part of the 1970s, and the Vietnam War was slowly winding down. Maj. Hilborn approached and said it was my turn to teach a class for the troops.

"What do you want me to cover?" I enquired. *"I don't care,"* the major replied. *"Just make it interesting."*

With a week to go, I thought I'd do something weird. I knew some of my colleagues in the Marine First and Third Divisions were using dowsing to locate enemy tunnels and weapons caches. I also knew it was not the first time the military had engaged in this practice.

Gen. Patton reportedly used dowsing to find new water wells to replace those destroyed by the Nazis. The practice also appeared in Russian Army manuals during the 1930s as a method for finding water in uninhabited areas.

So the next day, I found a couple of metal rods, bent them in the shape of an "L" and began my didactic presentation to the unit's enlisted personnel. Since I didn't know much about the subject, the class didn't last

very long. I gave a brief history, talked about its usage in Vietnam, and demonstrated my rods with one in each hand. In a matter of moments, the tools began to point over a certain spot in the ground.

No one, including myself, knew why. In addition, no one cared enough to grab a shovel and find out. Shortly thereafter, the major called me aside and asked with a stern look: “*Lieutenant, are you for real? Is this a joke or what?*”

I assured him with a straight face that it was no joke and that my subject matter was truly ‘*serious.*’

Suddenly, we both looked with amazement at the field where I had just conducted my class. There was the unit physician — holding my two divining rods — while the troops followed him around the open terrain in a snake-like procession! The major just stared in disbelief, rolled his eyes and walked away. So now that you know my story, I’m sure you must be wondering: Does dowsing really work?

There are so many different versions of this practice that I find it difficult to accept the ‘*energy emerging from the ground*’ theory. Perhaps its really a mental exercise, and the tools used are simply bridges from the mind into an invisible dimension where all things are connected — something Carl Jung called the ‘*collective unconscious.*’

I know that sounds bizarre, but people have been dowsing for hundreds of years, and there must be some kind of reward for their efforts.

But on the other hand, perhaps Dad was right. Maybe it’s just chance and delusional thinking. However, if people really and truly believe in the process, then who’s to say it can’t work for them?

Dowsing - Uses & Excuses, Part 1

There is a statement I use to open many of my talks with dowsers: "I have some good news and some bad news. There is a group of people who are among the most powerful on earth. The good news is, it is YOU, the dowsers. The bad news is that many of you don't realize it.

The reason may be based upon a saying I've also used for many years: "*People have given their souls to the priest and the preachers, their health to the doctors, their money to their bankers, their children to the school system. In so doing, they have lost power over their own lives.*"

Some of my experiences, thoughts and comments follow.

While being polite is certainly a trait to be admired, giving one's power away to someone, who may have less knowledge and integrity than you, is just not smart. I have chosen to address these issues because of the many comments I've received from good people over the years. There are many good and capable people in the dowsing community who don't use their abilities because of doubting themselves, or for fear someone else may disagree with them.

For example, a group of good people asked me to help them improve the quality of life in the schools their children attended. A year later they hadn't done anything. Their reason was that their work would interfere with other children in the school and they didn't think they had the right to do this. Of course it would interfere with the other children and teachers; that was the point of doing the work!!!

When my kid, April, started a new school at 14, the first thing I did was to clear the school of all the non-beneficial energies that could be thought of. On our first visit to the school, a teacher was informed of the plan and told there was nothing anyone could do about it and hoped the faculty liked the results. As a result, there were no problems during the four years of high school. One teacher commented about how peaceful, calm and FUN things were, since April began attending the school.

One interesting comment came from a person in the audience where this story was being told. She said that her son attended several schools in the course of his education. He had attended this same school during the time April was there, and it was the most pleasant of all those he had attended.

Did dowsing interfere with the lives of other people? CERTAINLY! Did I ask for permission of the authorities to do this? CERTAINLY NOT! I did ask my dowsing system if this was permissible and if there was any reason not to do it.

In other areas, a letter of thanks was received from a Canadian Mountie, expressing gratitude for the lowering of violence in a Native village where crime and violence had been severe. After working on the people in the village, the violent crime dropped to ZERO. Again, dowsing was used to interfere with the lives of people unknown to me and without their permission.

When telling people in class how to de-power killers and rapists, the common comment is, “*We can't interfere with a person's free will.*” Why

not? They are sure interfering with the free will of their victims. If we interfere first, maybe there won't be any victims.

Some have asked if I get permission before doing this work. Yes, but not necessarily from the criminal. I then put this question to the person asking: *“Do you really think that I hunt down the killers or rapists and ask if it is OK with them to do some dowsing work to change their lifestyle?”*

Then there is the argument that we are interfering with someone's karma. This amazes me because if we prevent an assault on someone, we have done an act of kindness and prevented the perpetrator from creating more bad karma for himself. Some have accused me of interfering with a person's karma by doing dowsing work to bring about better health. Maybe so. Then I probably interfered with an older, frightened woman's karma who had a flat tire on the interstate by stopping to offer help.

Somehow, the karma thing doesn't seem to apply to the complaining folks when they have a problem. Maybe this is a case of their dogma getting run over by their karma. When teaching folks to check the integrity of anyone wanting to sell them something or get them to join their cause, the question comes up, *“Isn't that invading their privacy?”* Maybe, but they are trying to invade your pocket and influence your life. You have a right to know if you are dealing with an honest person or a thief.

Another thought is that there are many possible futures, and we can use dowsing to attract the best possible future to us. But again, the question has come up, *“Aren't we depriving ourselves of learning experiences?”*

My answer is, *“Some learn by reading, some by listening, some by watching and some have to pee on the electric fence.”*

If we use dowsing to attract more positive events in our lives, we have spared ourselves the misery of bad decisions. Which do you think is the most intelligent choice?

Where Ley Lines Originate From

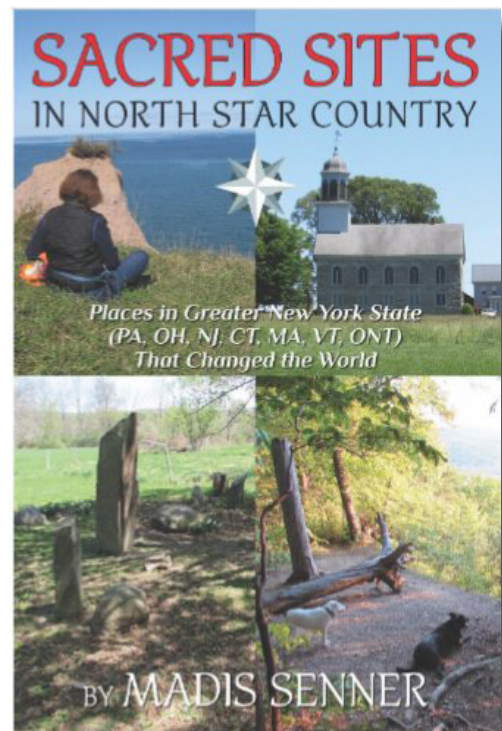
Ley Lines are a pretty contentious topic. It seems everybody has an opinion about what they are. Some point out that Alfred Watkins who coined the term ‘ley’ to describe a series of stone works, or places of worship that align in a straight line, never called such a connection a ‘Ley Line’.

There are those that say Ley Lines are pathways for UFO’s. The most recent remake of the movie Ghostbusters portrayed them as pathways for demons, or other kinds of entities in Unseen World. Others see them as portals. With so many diverse opinions it is not surprising that Ley Lines are a contentious subject.

To me this makes perfect sense because the Ley Lines, or least the Ley Lines I was shown and first dowsed out decades ago in the states, are part of Mother Earth’s Hidden Body and have a specific purpose—yet they can be used in a variety of ways. More on that later.

As a geomancer and Earth Healer I think it important that we know about Mother Earth’s Hidden Body and how it works. When I make a new discovery I try to determine what it does, what is its purpose, and is it part of a larger apparatus of our Mother’s in the Unseen World. That knowledge can be invaluable in helping heal our Mother and may even help make a more just and peaceful world by knowing how to apply that knowledge.

I share this with you in the hopes that you will come to understand what a ‘Ley Line’ is to me, and apply it in your geomancy work, and hope-



fully use that knowledge to work to heal our Mother.

Fields of Consciousness

Ley Lines are part of Mother's Hidden Body. I call the apparatus, the structure, from which they originate from a Field of Consciousness (FOC). I say consciousness because it can nourish your soul and raise your consciousness and make you a more loving and compassionate person. Because of this I refer to Ley Lines as '*Lines of Consciousness,*' or '*Spirit Lines.*'

Fields of consciousness have two major components; The Field emanating the consciousness, and the Spirit Lines that begin in a Field of Consciousness (FOC).

Please refer to the diagram below to better help you understand the following.

Spirit Lines begin in what I call an '*Originator.*' It will be located close to the Field. Anywhere from one to twelve Spirit Lines will begin from an originator. The number will depend upon the number of Fields stacked upon each other.

Yes, FOC come as single Fields or as many as twelve Fields stacked upon each other. The number of stacked Fields will coincide with the number of Spirit Lines originating from a FOC.

For example, a stacked FOC of six will have six Spirit Lines originate from it, whereas a stacked FOC of twelve will have twelve Spirit Lines originate from it. The higher the number of Fields stacked upon each other, the more potent the consciousness emanating from the FOC.

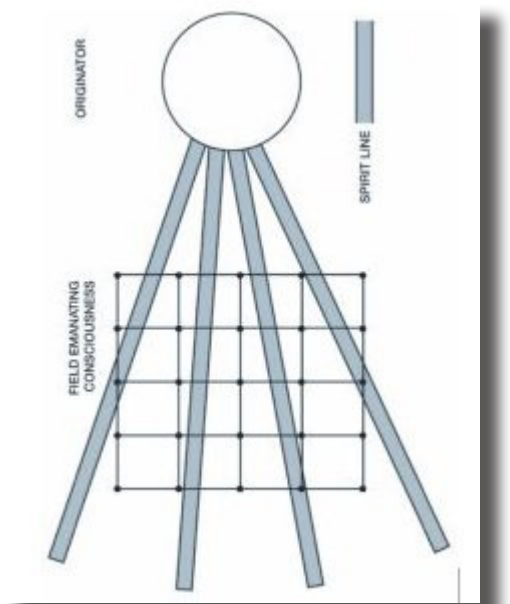


Illustration from Sacred Sites in North Star County. Image by Linda Donaldson of Imagine Design. Copyright Madis Senner ©

In the diagram above, four Spirit Lines begin from the Originator. They immediately pass over the Field, which is emanating what Hindu mystics call ‘*pure consciousness*,’ or close to that elevated state. It exudes the Divine’s highest aspiration for humankind—love, compassion, generosity, self-sacrifice altruism...

Spirit Lines pick up this divine consciousness when they pass over the Field. They then carry it with them as they go to the distant corners of the world, all the time interacting with the people and consciousness they come in contact with. The hope being that this contact can elevate the consciousness of the people and places the Ley Line encounters.

North Star Country

FOC are located in North America. Specifically, in America’s northeast and southern Ontario Canada. The center area being the Utica, Syracuse, Rochester, New York State Corridor—think of the route of the old Erie Canal, the route of the New York State Thruway (road); with Syracuse being the center. The stacked twelves are located in this center area and the number of FOC stacked upon each other diminishes the farther you get from this center area.

To conceptualize the size of the area from which Ley Lines originate from, visualize a large circle about 350 miles in radius whose center is in Syracuse, NY. To the north it stretches to Ottawa, Canada. To the east to Boston. To the south towards the state of Maryland. To the west towards Cleveland Ohio. I call it North Star Country because Freedom Seekers before the Civil War in America followed the north star to freedom there. North Star was also the name of the famous abolitionist Fredrick Douglass’ newspaper.

When we look at what we hold dear, many of those initiatives and movements were born in North Star Country.

Birthplace of Democracy—The great Haudenosaunee (Iroquois) prophet, the Peacemaker, united his people that had been warring, and gave

them the Great Law of Peace on the shores of Onondaga Lake (Syracuse, NY). It would serve as the model of democracy for America's founders hundreds of years later, and was recognized as such on October 21, 1988 when the Senate passed Hr. Cons. Res. 331, to acknowledge the contribution of the Iroquois Confederacy of Nations to the development of the United States Constitution... was influenced by the political system developed by the Iroquois Confederacy, as were many of the democratic principles which were incorporated into the constitution itself.

Birthplace of Women's Rights—The Seneca Falls convention of 1848 (July 19, 20 1848) took place in North Star Country. Many of its leaders lived on, or close to FOC, Susan B. Anthony, Elizabeth Cady Stanton, Matilda Joslyn Gage...

Birthplace of Religions and Religious movements— America's First and Second Great Awakening, New Age Movement, Perfectionism, Social Gospel, Niagara Movement (predecessor to the NAACP), Spiritualism, Mormonism, Millerism/Seven Day Adventists, Transcendentalism, Theosophy, Universalism.

As folklorist Carl Carmer described: *"It is a broad psychic highway, a thoroughfare of the occult... east of Albany to west of Buffalo... In no other area in the western Hemisphere have so many evidences of transcending mortal living been manifest..."*

Fields of consciousness can be powerfully transformative as many great reformers and leaders lived in close proximity to them; Harriet Tubman, Fredrick Douglass, William Seward...

I can attest to this as I have spent many hours over many years meditating on FOC, and believe they nourished my soul and helped with my spiritual transformation. However, for FOC to be properly operational they need to be at places that have a positive loving vibe—as human intention can elevate and make parts of our Mother so much more—A Positive Energy Vortex is a testament to this because it forms over time in

response to where mediation/ceremony/caring/giving took place.

Unfortunately, many places, like much of the world are caked over with the crud of selfishness, violence, hate etc. FOC at such locations carry no divine consciousness and can even carry the opposite. These places can be revived and I have worked to do so for many places over the years.

One place I hold dear, and have been a Keeper of for over twenty years, is the Peacemaker's Sanctuary at Onondaga Lake (pictured below), <https://peacemakerssanctuary.blogspot.com>. It has a stacked Field of twelve and is boosted by the Energy Vortices and Geospirals/Blind Springs found there. If you want to try and sense consciousness, get insights/epiphanies or just get really blissed out, this is the place to go. By praying, meditating, or doing ritual, at a FOC you can help strengthen it so it sends out a more potent source of consciousness—truly helping to make a better world.

Portals are often found next to the intersection of several Ley Lines. I use the term Portal loosely, because they are definitely like a station stop for a train—can they do more?, I just don't know.

As for UFO's traveling via Ley Lines, well, that's another topic, a really

big one. I will say the Final Frontier that Star Trek explored is within us and around us. We just need to expand what Aldous Huxley called our 'reducing valve' that confines our perception to the physical world.

Just remember Spirit Lines (Ley Lines) are meant to carry divine consciousness to the far corners of the Earth and make us more loving and compassionate. Unfortunately, most of them are sullied and can no longer perform that function. Praying, meditating or doing ritual on a Spirit Line can help raise its consciousness. Spirit Lines are also long distance pathways of travel in the Unseen World.

Strengthen the Light Within: Protection from Fear

Every time I teach a psychic development class, I devote a good section of time to question and answer periods. Though every class is different, I can always count on hearing a version of this question: “*How can we protect ourselves against the dark forces?*”



Despite hearing that question dozens of times, I don't have a set answer. All I know is that, once asked, I have to tread carefully, because I don't want to scare any beginning students from opening themselves up to experiencing the gifts of communication with spirit. Yet at the same time, I do believe that there is negative energy out there. I've met spirits that were what some might call ‘*dark*’ - but they weren't creatures created by Stephen King or Hollywood special effects technicians to scare the money out of the wallets of teenage moviegoers.

The dark spirits I've met are lost, lonely, confused and tormented souls who, for one reason or another, are afraid of crossing into the light. Most of them fear God won't let them into ‘*heaven*’ because of errors they committed while alive. Other spirits don't know they're dead, or don't want to accept the fact that they've left the Earth plane.

And a few are angry and have no way to get rid of their negative energy. Therefore, they hang around the Earth plane as poltergeists and play tricks, and occasionally latch themselves onto a Ouija board and try to lure people astray. (Which is why I avoid Ouija boards.)

These spirits need to be treated with love and compassion. I know several rescue mediums who feel it's a noble calling to guide these lost souls

into the light. These very strong-willed mediums don't take their jobs lightly, they strongly believe in their power and that their spirit guides are powerful.



There are two key words here: fear and power. So, whenever anyone asks me about protecting themselves from 'the dark,' I remember those two words. Because fear feeds negative energy. And belief in the strength of your self-confidence and self-love will defeat anything.

Many people are told to visualize pure, white light, which acts as protection in certain situations. White light is also as a symbol for the Divine, and calling white light into a troubling experience is asking God or the energy of love to be with you.

I also believe white light symbolizes the power of our higher self. And what makes up our higher self? The knowledge that we are strong, wise beings with a deep sense of confidence and commitment to expressing the love of the universe, which flows in us and through us.

So: How can you protect yourself against the darkness? By turning on a light - your light. By strengthening the light within you, and understanding that you can shine as bright as the sun. Meditate on this, and repeat this mantra often: "*I am in control of my life. I control my light.*" Questions about protection also come from clients who sometimes feel afraid that they may not be in control of their lives.

“If we did all the things we are capable of doing, we would literally astound ourselves.” – Thomas Edison

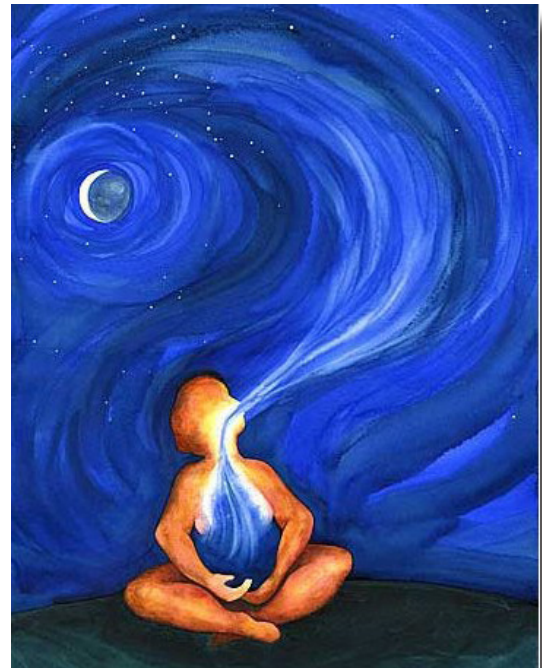

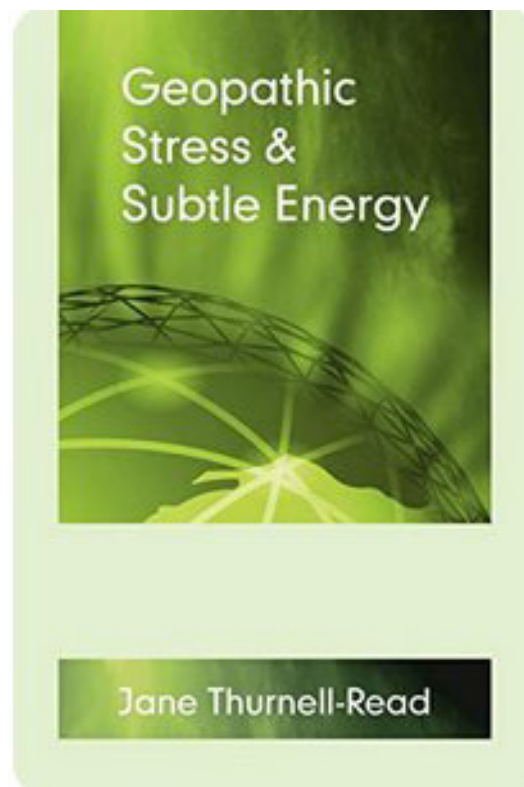

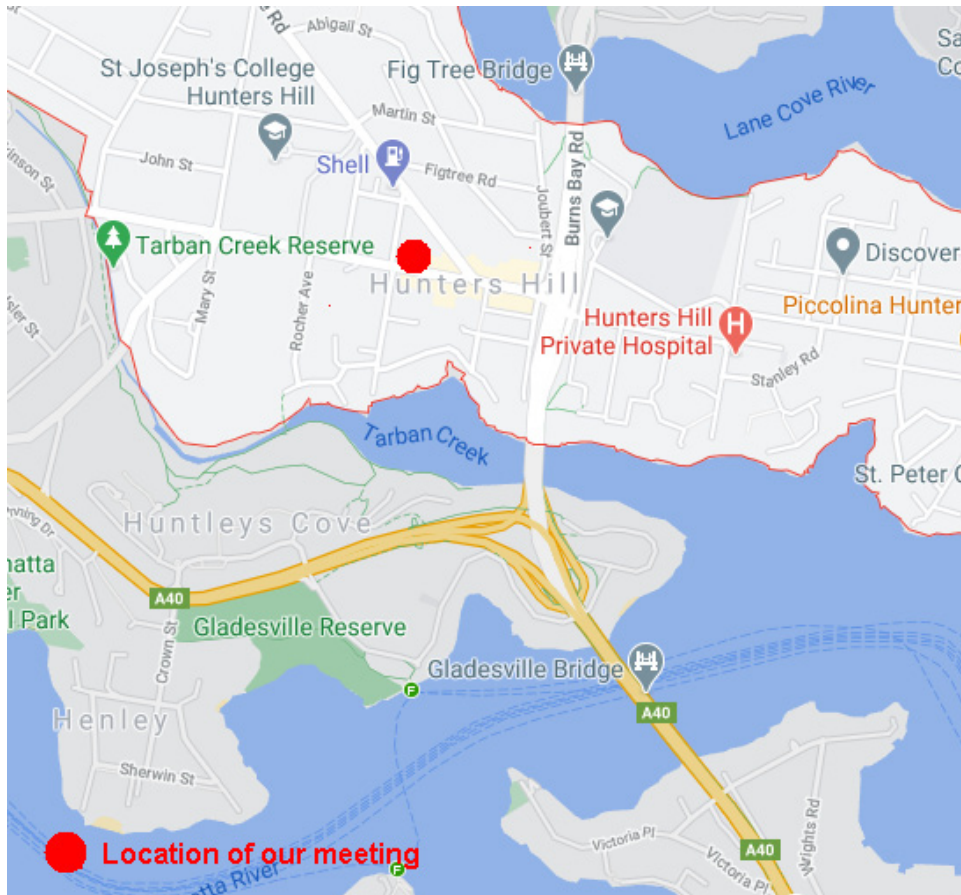
